I regret to announce the death of Deacon A. John Marinari of the Archdiocese of Washington, who died on Monday, August 2, 2010 at 74 years of age. He is survived by Joan, his wife of 55 years, four sons, five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Deacon Marinari was ordained to the permanent diaconate on October 15, 1983. Following ordination, he was assigned to Our Lady of Sorrows Parish, Takoma Park, Maryland. In 1986, he was assigned to Saint Michael the Archangel Parish, Silver Spring, Maryland where he served until he retired from active ministry in 2002.

A viewing will be held on Friday, August 6, 2010 from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., and 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., at Saint John the Evangelist Parish, 10103 Georgia Avenue, Silver Spring, Maryland. A Funeral Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, August 7, 2010 at 11:30 a.m. at Saint John the Evangelist. Interment will follow immediately at Gate of Heaven Cemetery, 13801 Georgia Avenue, Silver Spring, Maryland.
