LENTEN SCHEDULE AND ACTIVITIES

WHAT IS LENT?

Lent is the season of the Church year that provides for us an opportunity for profound and radical change through reconciliation and the forgiveness of our sins. It is that time that we journey through prayer, fasting and almsgiving in preparation for the celebration of the resurrection. Lent is also a baptismal season in which we pray for those preparing to be baptized at Easter. It begins in the desert, a place of struggle, and ends upon the cross. We imitate Jesus by shedding our old selves and finally rising with him. This schedule of activities and events invites us to live this season with faith, hope, forgiveness and love.

LENTEN REGULATIONS ON FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday, February 17, 2010, marks the beginning of Lent. The following fast and abstinence regulations are observed:

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years of age and older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics, who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years of age. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

The special Paschal fast and abstinence are observed on Good Friday and, where possible, on Holy Saturday. On these days, Christians prepare themselves by these disciplines in anticipation of the renewal of their baptismal commitment on Easter.
